This course teaches participants how to carry out risk assessments in a format that suits their business.

COURSE DURATION

COURSE METHODOLOGY AND ASSESSMENT

The course, while tutor-led, is presented in a modular format, which includes problem-based learning and practical skills.

Assessments of the learners are carried out by the course tutor through observations of their group work/practical skills and their engagement and participation on the course.

The minimum number of learners on the course is 6; the maximum number of learners is 12.
